
#### Happy Birthday, Prime Minister Barrow!

## Women's Month 2017, "Empowering Women in a Changing World: Plant 50:50 by 2030."

Women's Day is celebrated each year on March 8<sup>th</sup>. It's a day of global celebration of the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women. This theme for the 2017 Women's Day is "Empowering Women in a Changing World: Plant 50:50 by 2030."

The theme focuses on the impact that rapid changes in technology and globalization is having and can have on the status of women.

In Belize, the entire month of March is dedicated to celebrating the achievements of Belizean women.

The activities are headed by the Ministry of Human Development, Social Transformation and Poverty Alleviation. According to the Ministry, the month is used to not only celebrate women, but also to reflect on the progress made in gender equality and equity, and to renew commitment to the continued advancement of women. On March 29<sup>st</sup>, 2017, 17 women will be honored at the 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Outstanding Women's Awards Ceremony.

#### Belmopan City Council officially launches Municipal Bond

The Belmopan City Council (Bmp Citco) held a press conference this morning to officially launch their Municipal Bond.

According to Mayor Khalid Belisle, Bmp Citco is undertaking a \$6.5 million public works project to

improve the quality of life of the city's residents; the project will be financed by the Bond.

Residents are encouraged to invest in the Municipal Bond scheme and can purchase a Bond Certificate starting at \$1,000. The bonds have thirteen (13) individual tranches, Tranche 1-13, with maturities from two (2) to fourteen (14) years.

Interest on the bonds will be paid every six months on February 1<sup>st</sup> and August 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. The Bonds will be managed by Legacy Fund Limited and the fiscal agent is Heritage Trust Financial Services Limited.
